### **DOMINIQUE THORMANN NAMED CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER OF THE RENAULT GROUP**

Dominique Thormann has been named Chief Financial Officer of the Renault group, replacing Thierry Moulouguet, effective from 1 July 2010. He becomes a member of Renault's Group Executive Committee, reporting directly to Carlos Ghosn, Chairman and CEO of Renault.

Dominique Thormann remains Chairman of RCI Banque.

Effective from the same date, Thierry Moulouguet is appointed Director and Special Adviser to Carlos Ghosn, President of the Renault-Nissan Alliance.

***Dominique Thormann**, born in 1954, began his career as a credit analyst at Chase Manhattan Bank in New York in 1979, before going on to hold several international positions in Rome, Milan and Paris. He joined Renault Crédit International in 1989 as International Treasurer and took charge of Investor Relations for Renault in 1994. In 1999 he joined Nissan Motor Co. Ltd. in Tokyo as Deputy General Manager, Investor Relations and Financial Strategy. He went on to become Vice President, Global Communications and Investor Relations and then, in 2004, Senior Vice President in charge of Administration and Finance for Nissan Europe, based in Paris. He joined Nissan North America on July 1, 2006 as Senior Vice President in charge of Administration and Finance. He was appointed Chairman of RCI Banque in October 2009.*

*Dominique Thormann graduated with a BA in International Relations from Johns Hopkins University (USA) in 1975. He is also a graduate of the JHU School of Advanced International Studies in Washington D.C. and obtained a diploma in international relations in Bologna, Italy in 1977.*

***Thierry Moulouguet**, born in 1951, began his career in 1976 at the Ministry of Economy and Finance and worked in the civil service until 1991. He joined Renault in February 1991 in charge of group financial relations, before being named Vice President, Capital Expenditures Controller in 1996. In 1999, following the signature of the Renault-Nissan Alliance, he joined Nissan Motor in Japan as Senior Vice President, Finance of Nissan. He was appointed Executive Vice President, Chief Financial Officer of Nissan in 2000. In September 2003 he joined the Renault Management Committee as Adviser to the Chairman and in January 2004 became Executive Vice President and Chief Financial Officer, joining Renault's Group Executive Committee. From February 2006 to December 2008 he was Leader of the Americas Region in addition to his duties as Chief Financial Officer.*

*Thierry Moulouguet is a graduate of Ecole Nationale d'Administration.*
