JOSE VICENTE DE LOS MOZOS HAS BEEN APPOINTED VICE PRESIDENT, MANUFACTURING ASSEMBLY PLANTS, RENAULT GROUP, FROM NOVEMBER 2, 2009

On November 2, 2009, Jose Vicente de los Mozos takes up the post of Vice President, Manufacturing Assembly Plants, Renault group. He replaces Denis Barbier. He will report to Michel Gornet, Executive Vice President, Manufacturing and Logistics.

Born on October 15, 1962, José de los Mozos holds a degree in Aeronautical Engineering from the Universidad Politecnica de Madrid and a Master's degree in Manufacturing Management Techniques from CESEM Madrid. He joined Renault in November 1978 as an apprentice. After graduating, he became a production engineer at the Valladolid plant. In 1990, he was appointed unit supervisor in the pressing methods department, and, in 1999, head of pressing. He was then transferred to the Palencia plant as pressing and body assembly manager. In 2003, he joined Nissan Motor Iberica in Barcelona as Deputy Managing Director, Manufacturing, before becoming Managing Director of Nissan Motor Iberica in 2005, and Vice President, Spanish Industrial Operations in 2006. In September 2008 he joined FICOSA (automotive supplier), as Chief Operating Officer (COO), a post he holds until October 30, 2009.
