LAURENCE DORS APPOINTED EVP, CORPORATE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE RENAULT GROUP

Laurence Dors has been appointed Executive Vice President, Corporate Secretary General of the Renault group in charge of the CEO Office, effective from June 15, 2010. She replaces Bernard Rey, who is devoting himself to Renault Sport F1. Laurence Dors will also be responsible for the Public Affairs Department, succeeding Christian Husson, who will focus on the Legal Department, the secretariat of the Board of Directors and the bureau of representation of the Renault-Nissan Alliance in Brussels.

Laurence Dors joined the Renault group on March 1, 2010. She is the second woman to join the Renault Executive Committee, which now comprises nine members. She reports to Carlos Ghosn, Chairman and CEO of Renault.

*Born on March 16, 1956, **Laurence DORS** graduated from Ecole normale Supérieure and Ecole nationale d'Administration. She started her career in the international services of the French Ministry of Economy and Finance where she held several executive management positions. In 1994 she held a position as advisor on international economics with the French Minister of Economy Edmond Alphandéry and then to French Prime Minister Alain Juppé. In 1997, she was appointed Deputy Director at Direction des Relations Economiques Extérieures. In April 1998, she joined Lagardère Group at the International division. She was appointed Corporate Secretary for EADS international from 2000 to 2003 and then for EADS group from 2003. In April 2008, she joined Dassault Systems, as Senior Executive Vice President Global Development and Resources.*
