## **MICHEL FAIVRE- DUBOZ APPOINTED GENERAL MANAGER OF RENAULT IN MOROCCO**

From September 1, 2010, Michel FAIVRE-DUBOZ, is appointed General Manager of Renault in Morocco. He will be in charge of all Renault operations in Morocco, including the industrial project of Tangier, the SOMACA manufacturing plant and the commercial activities.

He reports to Jacques Chauvet, Leader of the Euromed Region.

Michel Faivre-Duboz is a member of the Renault Management Committee.

*Born on April 30, 1951 in Morocco, Michel Faivre-Duboz studied as an engineer at the Ecole Catholique d'Arts et Métiers de Lyon (ECAM). He joined Renault in 1973 as a bodywork synthesis engineer. He was in charge of the Renault 25 (1979) and Renault 21 (1984) projects, then went on to become head of manufacturing engineering and new work at the Sandouville plant in 1986. Between 1990 and 1997, he was appointed Director of the Mégane range Project. He was named Senior Vice President, Vehicle Engineering Development in 1999 and became a member of the Renault Management Committee. On January 2, 2008, he was appointed Senior Vice President, Global Supply Chain.*
