The future Renault Nissan Plant in Tangiers rewarded.

The fifth edition of the European Union's Sustainable Energy Europe Awards drew 303 project entries in six categories. Renault-Nissan's Tangiers plant came first in the "Producing" category.

The plant, to the south of Tangiers, will be opening in 2012 as the world's first automotive production facility to boast zero carbon emissions. CO₂ emissions will be cut by close to 98%, and water consumption will be 70% lower than at a conventional plant. All Renault production sites worldwide are already certified to ISO 14 001, and the new facility takes Renault's environmental commitment a step further still.

The plant will be employing a local workforce of 6,000, trained at the brand new Automotive Industry Training Institute (IFMIA) in Tangiers, opened last month.
